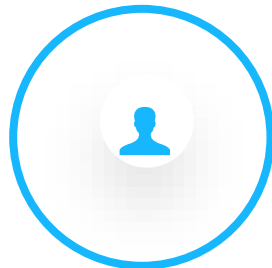
Improving Health of Older Adults in Care Facilities

Purpose

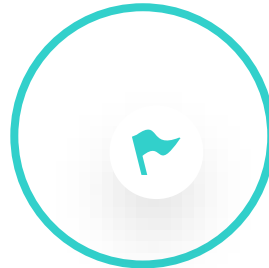
Research to improve health, quality, and equity for older adults in care facilities

Program Attributes

- ❖ Use already existing datasets for the research being conducted
- ❖ Include stakeholders from clinical, programmatic, or policy arenas



Approx. \$125k-\$150k per award
(plus 10% indirect)



Grant term:
2 years

• • • Topics

- ❖ Palliative, end of life and hospice care
- ❖ Innovations in workforce roles and expertise
- ❖ Role of family members and informal caregivers
- ❖ Effects of isolation & loneliness on health & well-being
- ❖ Racial, ethnic, gender, or income disparities
- ❖ Specialized needs for those with disabilities, serious mental illness, or addiction

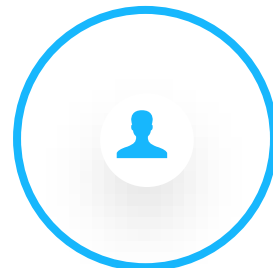
Advancing Promising Approaches to Achieve a Higher Value Healthcare System

Purpose

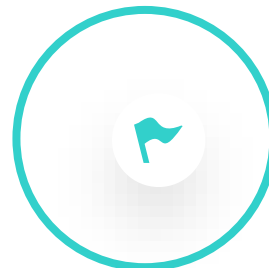
Research on approaches and tools that organizations can readily use to improve the value of the healthcare they provide to patients and communities

Program Attributes

- ❖ Linked to ongoing work to improve health
- ❖ Must partner with or be embedded with a healthcare service organization



\$400,000 (plus 10% indirect)



Grant term:
2 years

••• Topics

- ❖ Models of care, coverage or system change
- ❖ Treatments, tests, and screenings with harms that outweigh benefits
- ❖ Consumer tools that assist with cost, other factors
- ❖ Conversations between patients and care teams on cost or alternative treatments
- ❖ Interventions that increase equity



Phase 1 Letter of Intent

Another Look LOI is due **March 1**
Greater Value Portfolio LOI is due **March 8**

- Must be a blinded Word document
- Describe the role of stakeholder or partner
- Provide overview of the research project
- Form and instructions on the website

Two phases

- ❖ Letter of intent
- ❖ Invited application

Phase 2 Invited Application

Another Look application is due **June 7**
Greater Value Portfolio application is due **June 16**

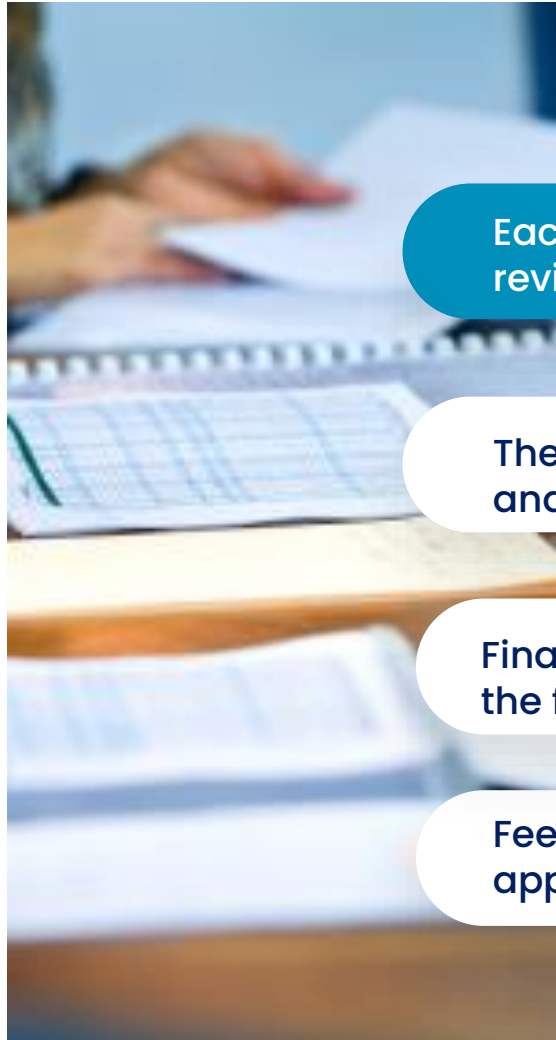


How we review and rate applications

• • • REVIEW PROCESS

Our goal is to have a review that....

- Is equitable and transparent
- Uses high standards (re: COI, privacy)
- Is efficient and straightforward for applicants



Each application is assigned to be reviewed by 3 reviewers and 1 biostatistician

The review committee meets to discuss applications and score proposals

Final decisions regarding grant awards are made by the foundation's trustees

Feedback is provided to applicant regarding application and award decision

The goal of the R3 grant program is to help researchers better prepare their health interventions for adoption and use in real-world settings. The R3 funds will enable the grantees to access experts in areas relevant to scaling, spread, and implementation.
